Whereas the Chief and Council are the duly elected leadership of the Nooaitch Indian Band and as such:

- 1. Are the local government authority of the Nooaitch Indian Band within the meaning of the Indian Act;
- 2. Are responsible for the health and safety of all residents within the lands that have been set aside for the use and benefit of the Nooaitch Indian Band:

Whereas, Nooaitch Indian Band maintains IR 9 and 10.

Whereas an extreme weather event has occurred over the past 24 hours causing flooding in Merritt and upstream of Nooaitch.

Whereas elders and young children may be at significant risk.

Whereas the main bridge over the Nicola may be at risk.

Quorum:

Therefore, be it resolved that the Chief and Council or its delegate are hereby ordering that an Evacuation Order be issued for Nooaitch's IR#10.

Be it further resolved that that Nooaitch EOC seek resources to support the community evacuees.

Evacuees should travel to Kamloops and register at Kamloops Emergency Social Services (ESS) at MacaCarthur Island or Kelowna Emergency Social Services at 1700 Parkinson Way. Evacuees may be able to register online.

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police and/or other agencies will be expediting this action in these areas on behalf of the Nooaitch Indian Band.
