PROGRAM: Declaration of a Local State of Emergency - SIMILKAMEEN FLOODING

WHEREAS:

At a duly convened Band Council meeting the Lower Similkameen Chief and Council do recognize and accept their duties and responsibilities in relation to effective governance of all affairs for the Lower Similkameen

WHEREAS there is <u>SIMILKAMEEN FLOODING</u> in close proximity to the Lower Similkameen Indian Band Reserve lands; and

WHEREAS there is imminent threat to Community Health, safety and life;

WHEREAS this <u>SIMILKAMEEN FLOODING</u> requires prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to protect the health, safety and welfare of people on I.R No. 2; I.R. No. 7 & 8; I.R. No 9; I.R. No. 10; and those **properties closest** to the Similkameen River and the impacts of crossing the Chopaka Bridge and/or the Ashnola Red Bridge.

NOW THEREFORE: IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Lower Similkameen Indian Band designated employees, servants and agents are empowered by a duly signed Band Council Resolution pursuant to the Indian Act (R.S. 1985) to do all acts and implement all procedures that are considered necessary to prevent or to alleviate the effects of the emergency, including:

- Authorize or require any person to render assistance of a type that the person is qualified to
 provide or that otherwise is or may be required to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of
 an emergency or disaster.
- Control or prohibit travel to or from any area designated in the declaration within the local authority's jurisdiction.
- Provide for the restoration of essential facilities and the distribution of essential supplies and provide, maintain and coordinate emergency medical, welfare and other essential services in any part of the local authority's jurisdiction.
- Cause the removal of persons personal property from any area designated in the declaration within the local authority's jurisdiction that is or may be affected by an emergency or a disaster.
- Authorize the entry into any building or on any land, without warrant, by any person in the
 course of implementing an emergency plan or program or if otherwise considered by the local
 authority to be necessary to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of an emergency or
 disaster.
- Cause the demolition or removal of any, structures if the demolition or removal is considered by the local authority to be necessary or appropriate in order to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster.
- Construct works considered by the local authority to be necessary or appropriate to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster.

Community Alert

Evacuation <u>Alert</u> Issued for Chopaka and W.Similkameen, Alexis 9 and Ashnola Village

Due to the water levelsapproaching the Ashnola Red Bridge and a potentially compromising Chopaka bridge via debris, we are issuing an **Evacuation Alert** for all residents listed on Evacuation Alert BCR (attached)

An evacuation **ALERT** provides you **time to prepare** for an evacuation order.

If an evacuation ORDER is later issued, then you will need to leave your home and register at our Emergency Operations Re-ception Centre at the LSIB Gym for lodging and food vouchers.

When an Alert is issued:

- Pack a bag with clothes, medication, importantdocuments, and any pet food, collars, leashes
- Keep your packed bag in your vehicle or close to the door
- keep your phone charged and make sure your ringers are on
- Make a plan with your family for a meeting place (if applicable)

If you will choose to remain in your home:

- Make sure you have water, food, and necessary medication for at least 72 hours
- Plan for a power outage
- keep your family informed
- Make sure your gas tank is full

BAND COUNCIL RESOLUTION 021 FOR ISSUANCE OF AN EVACUATION ALERT

On November 15, 2021 at 2:00 pm the Lower Similkameen Indian Band Council, pursuant to the Authority of the Chief and Council as per its funding agreement with Canada which outlines that Chief and Council "shall at all times provide for the preservation of public health and safety and the protection of the environment and upon determination by the primary response agency issues an evacuation alert for Chopaka I.R No. 7/8; Similkameen I.R. No 2; Alexis I.R No. 9; Ashnola I.R. 10; and,

The evacuation alert will remain in effect until:

- the primary response agency has notified the Lower Similkameen Indian Band that the threat to the health and safety of the community members and property has diminished and can be rescinded; or
- the primary response agency has notified the Lower Similkameen Indian Band that the threat to the health and safety of the community members and property has increased and an upgrade to an evacuation order is required.

The Lower Similkameen Indian Band Council will notify community members of the evacuation alert via one of the following methods:

- Telephone
- Door-to-door
- > Social media
- Notice posted at critical service buildings i.e.: Band Office, Health Centre, School, etc.
